2nd person singular	You	<u>play</u>
3rd person singular	She/He	<u>plays</u>
1st person plural	We	<u>play</u>

3rd person plural	They	<u>play</u>

Simple Past

I	<u>played</u>
You	<u>played</u>
She/He	<u>played</u>
We	<u>played</u>
You	<u>played</u>
They	<u>played</u>

Simple Future

1st person singular	I	<u>will play</u>
2nd person singular	You	<u>will play</u>
3rd person singular	She/He	<u>will play</u>
1st person plural	We	<u>will play</u>
2nd person plural	You	<u>will play</u>
3rd person plural	They	<u>will play</u>

Present Continuous

I	<u>am playing</u>
You	<u>are playing</u>
He/She	<u>is playing</u>
We	<u>are playing</u>
You	<u>are playing</u>
They	<u>are playing</u>

Present Perfect

1st person singular	I	<u>have played</u>
2nd person singular	You	<u>have played</u>
3rd person singular	He/She	<u>has played</u>
1st person plural	We	<u>have played</u>
2nd person plural	You	<u>have played</u>
3rd person plural	They	<u>have played</u>

Present Perfect Continuous

I	<u>have been playing</u>
You	<u>have been playing</u>
He/She	<u>has been playing</u>
We	<u>have been playing</u>
You	<u>have been playing</u>
They	<u>have been playing</u>
